Certification for our area of specialty,
PeriAnesthesia Nursing, is the hot topic these
days, and there is much work to be completed!
This project requires significant commitment and
the work has already begun. The "Proposal
Committee" (members of NAPANC) is busy
developing the first proposal to be submitted to
the Canadian Nurses Association (CNA) to apply
for the privilege of being honored with our own
Certification Examination. It is a significant
commitment on the part of the CNA too, so they
need to hear that we, as PeriAnesthesia Nurses,
are serious about this exam.

The prerequisites for our Proposal being approved are a lengthy checklist of documentation and data collection. But here is where you can help:

We need 1,000 PeriAnesthesia Nurses from across Canada, to add their names to our list to signify their wish to write/take the Certification Examination.
